### **£1,890 RED AND WHITE DAIRY HEIFER TOPS ROSS SALE**

A red and white calved heifer topped the September proceedings at the Monthly Collective Sale of Dairy Cattle at Ross-on-Wye Cattle Market. She was consigned by Brownswood Holsteins of Worcester and sold for £1,890 (1,800gns).

Auctioneer Gwilym Richards reported a very level and consistent trade with a shortage of high fliers amongst the heifers with a better standard of cows on offer.

Cows sold to £1,838 (1,750gns) for a 3<sup>rd</sup> calver from Robert and Linda Tarver of Pershore.

Black and White calved heifers sold to £1,785 (1,700gns) from Ben and Mark Stephens of Westbury-on-Severn.

The best heifers and cows were regularly selling around the £1,680 (1,600gns) mark.
