Another busy week at Drayton with a total of 252 dairy cattle sold with the best at the weekly sale selling to a top of £2,020 from The Whitticase Family of St. Martins.

Trade has been easing back of late with the wet weather affecting the harvest and the collapse of the local Tomlinson's Dairies destroying confidence.

However, quality always sells with the best two heifers from The Whitticase Family of St. Martins averaging £2,000 with others at £1,910. T.A. Dobson & Son of Bickley sold heifers to £1,810.

There were few first quality cattle forward with the best quality cows selling to £1,780 for a third calver from Mr G.J. Sutton, Astbury. Others to £1,600.
