

**CLASSIC CARS TO £7,000
& VINTAGE TRACTORS TO £2,200**

Auctioneers Gwilym Richards report that over 300 buyers from all corners of England and Wales attended the dispersal sale of the collection of classic cars and vintage tractors and equipment accumulated over the years by the late Bryan Walters at his Woolaston home near Lydney in the Forest of Dean.

Top price was £7,000 for the 1965 Wolseley 6/110 car with £2,900 being paid for the 1984 Bentley Mulsanne which was a non-runner.

Tractors sold to £2,200 for the 1978 International 784, £2,000 for the 1967 McCormick International 434, £1,600 and £1,550 for the other McCormick Internationals, £1,250 for the 1977 Zetor, £1,200 for the Nuffield 1060 and £800 for the 1951 Grey Fergie TE20. The Kubota STE A-15 tractor sold for £2,150.

The International 435 Pick Up Baler made £1,180 and the International Drot sold for £950.
