First of all, a very big thank you to all the vendors and purchasers embracing the new Covid-19 restrictions to enable the dairy auction to resume after the six week break.

Secondly, the trade was much better than anticipated with no shortage of buyers in attendance enabling all cattle to be sold. In actual fact, some buyers went home empty handed.

It was virtually all heifers with only one cow forward.

The heifers sold to £1,900 from A.A. Winstanley & Partners, Audlem with others from the same home selling at £1,810 and £1,780. Mr Richard Lewis, Carmarthen sold at £1,820 and £1,700. Mr Rhys Jones, Kidwelly received £1,720 and Mr Ifan Thomas, Swansea sold to £1,680.
