

GUEST DAIRY CATTLE TO £1,300 AT ROSS MARKET

The dispersal of the David Guest's mixed herd of Holstein Friesians and Coloured Dairy Cattle moved to Ross-on-Wye Market from their Chepstow farm for sale convenience attracted many keen buyers from 13 counties stretching from Staffordshire in the north to Somerset in the south and from Carmarthenshire in the west to Leicestershire in the east.

Top price was £1,300 for a black and white cow dried off for calving her 3rd calf to the Simmental bull in January.

A similar black and white cow due with her 4th calf sold for £1,250.

An Ayrshire cow due her 5th calf in February sold for £1,020.

Served heifers sold to £900 and maiden heifers to £700.
