ANOTHER SPARKLING CHRISTMAS MARKET 3 AT £2,450 – 18 OVER £2,000

The Christmas Show & Sale attracted a quality entry which was ably judged by Richard Bowdler with both the best cow and best heifer selling for £2,450.

The champion and first prize cow was a third calver from JWP Farming, Lutterworth. The reserve champion was the first prize heifer from Andrew Shakeshaft, Colemere.

A third calver from David Monk, Ormskirk was the second prize cow and also sold for £2,450. David Monk also sold a heifer for £2,300.

GJ Sutton, Astbury sold a second calver for £2,320, and heifers at £2,250, £2,120 and £2,080 with their five cattle averaging £2,144. The Whitticase Family, St Martins sold to £2,280, £2,100 and £2,020 averaging £2,133 for their three.

Skinner Bros, Melton Mowbray, sold cows to £2,280 and £1,980, and heifers to £2,100. Matthew Weaver, Stone, sold heifers to £2,280 and £2,050, Rob Gadsbey, Yarlet to £2,050, RG Woolley & Son, Acton £1,950, RW & EE Edwards & Sons, Whitchurch £1,940 and OC Whittaker & Sons, Tabley £1,900.

OC Whittaker & Sons also sold a Dairy Shorthorn heifer for £1,900, an Ayrshire heifer from A Coutts & Sons, Knutsford £1,750 and a Jersey heifer from Richard Thompson, Sudbury £1,650.

All cattle sold with nine cattle in the £1,900s, five in the £1,800s and three quartered heifers from £1,000 upwards.

A Danish Red cow and her calf sold for £1,350 and served heifers to £750.
