TERRIFIC LEVEL TRADE – 100% CLEARANCE COWS TO £2,150 – HEIFERS TO £2,100

Today's entry was all sold on a fast trade with no big prices but consistent throughout with the 35 milkers averaging £1,736.

Cows were in great demand with a second calver from Skinner Brothers, Melton Mowbray claiming the top price of £2,150.

Phillip Adams, Butterton sold his third calver for £1,950 and his second calvers for £1,900 and £1,880. Hankins Heys Farm, Nantwich sold a second calver for £1,900. All cows averaged £1,883.

Top priced heifer was £2,100 from John Griffin, Sutton Coldfield with his other heifer selling for £1,900 to average £2,000. Hankins Heys Farm sold to £2,050 and Brownswood Holsteins, Worcester to £2,020 and £1,920. Anthony Madders, Adbaston sold to £1,900 and £1,880. In all, 19 heifers sold for over £1,600.

Cross-bred calved heifers sold from £1,300 to £1,380.

It was only the heifers with faults that sold for lesser money with the cheapest of these at £1,240.

Heifer calves sold to £155.
