£2,500 HEIFER - £2,220 COW - 11 OVER £2,000 - ALL SOLD

The April Show & Sale was judged by Dan Howell and his choice of Champion Heifer came from Hankins Heys Farm, Nantwich and sold for the day's top price of £2,500. The second prize heifer from the same home sold for £2,220. The third prize heifer from Brownswood Holsteins, Worcester made £2,000.

Other heifers over £2,000 included Skinner Bros, Melton Mowbray £2,250, Ray Brown & Partners, Twemlows £2,150, £2,050 and £2,000, and Malcolm Trevor-Jones, Oswestry £2,120.

Cows sold to £2,220 for the first prize cow, a second calver from WC Hill & Sons, Leicester, and their second prize second calver sold for £2,040. Ray Brown & Partners sold their second calver for £2,120.

Richard Thompson, Sudbury very kindly donated a fifth calver which sold for £1,500.to the DEC Ukraine Humanitarian Appeal.

In-calf heifers due in June sold to £1,500 from Dave Waring. A very large entry of heifer calves sold to £580 and £500 twice from the Whitticase family, St Martins and their consignment of 12 averaged £485.

Outwintered cross-bred calved heifers sold to £750 and cross-bred heifer calves to £110.

Next week's sale includes a 16 month old black and white pedigree British Blue bull.
