ELECTRIC TRADE – ALL HEIFERS AVERAGE £1,934 COWS TO £2,320 – HEIFERS TO £2,250 TWICE

Today's trade was on fire from the word go with the first animal in the ring a calved heifer from the Pembertons at Whitchurch selling for £2,250.

Numbers of fresh calved heifers were short with all forward selling for an average of £1,934 and two thirds of them selling over £2,000. Andrew Ball, Sandbach £2,250, Steve Hill, Hydaways £2,120, Wynford Wagyu, Newport £2,080, Malcolm Trevor-Jones, Oswestry £2,000 (Ayrshire).

The day's top price was £2,320 for a second calver from Malcolm Trevor-Jones with another of his second calvers making £1,910.

The part dispersal for John Hill, Lutterworth of his cows sold to £1,750 (third calver), £1,740 (4th calver) and averaged £1,440 for all 22 including stale and three quartered cows. The next part of this dispersal is in a fortnight.

Everything sold really well today including light quartered cows to £1,610 and a heifer calved virtually a year ago and not back in-calf to £1,480. The lowest priced milkers were £900 and £950.

Heifer calves were also a better trade selling to £110.

The British Blue stock bull (23 months) sold for £2,250.

Next week's sale includes a 2 year old pedigree Simmental bull.
