WONDERFUL OPENING SALE FOR THE WESTERN HOLSTEIN CLUB HEIFERS TO £2,620 – COWS TO £2,400 – 20 OVER £2,000

A truly brilliant start to the Monthly Pedigree Show & Sale supported by the Western Holstein Club with a huge crowd enjoying the tremendous busy vibe of the weekly market.

Last week's trade was described as electric but this week it moved up another gear with the excellent choice of John Bayley of Nuneaton as the Club Champion selling for the top price of £2,620, she was the first prize heifer from Arthur Grimshaw, Bolton.

The Club reserve champion was the best cow from Tim and Mike Rees, Hunterson, a second calver selling for £2,050. John Chorlton sold a fourth calver for £2,100.

In the non Club section, the best cow from Malcolm Trevor-Jones, Oswestry sold for £2,400 which was a second calver. Malcolm also sold a third calver for £2,350 and calved heifers to £2,320 and £2,020.

Second calvers from David Britton, Norfolk sold at £2,400, and £2,370 and £2,000 from Phillip Adams, Butterton.

Heifers from John Griffin, Canwell sold to £2,150 and £2,050, Andrew Ball, Smallwood £2,200, Dafydd Jones, Corwen £2,150 and £2,080, Brownswood Holsteins, Worcester £2,150, PB, BJ & TG Pemberton, Whitchurch £2,100

Ayrshire calved heifers from Steve and Rob Bailey, Lightwood Green made £2,320 and £2,200. Crossbred heifers sold to £1,300 and Jersey calved heifers sold for £1,100 and £1,050.

Heifer calves were again a better trade selling to £220 and averaging £200 for the Holstein Friesians and grazing types to £125.

A 2 year old Simmental bull sold for £2,700.
