Another big entry and a great trade with every dairy animal sold.

David Monk of Lancashire claimed the top spot at £2,600 with a heifer. Close behind was Liam Phillips of Llanymynech selling two at £2,500 each and another at £2,350 to average £2,450 for all three. Another Lancastrian Anthony Grimshaw sold at £2,500.

Other heifers over £2,000 – Malcolm Trevor-Jones, Oswestry £2,280 and £2,180. Frank Speed, Betley £2,280 and £2,100. Brownswood Holsteins, Worcester £2,250 and £2,080. Lee, Lancashire £2,220. Andrew Ball, Sandbach £2,200. Paul Mason, Shrewsbury £2,150. David Monk £2,150.
