HEIFERS AND COWS AT £2,500 - NINE OVER £2,400 - SIXTEEN OVER £2,000

Trade was red hot at the May Show and Sale supported by the Western Holstein Club which was judged by Peter and Simon Stone. Their choices topped both heifer and cow classes.

The pedigree champion was the first prize cow, the second calver Clayden Eubank Helsinki from Clayden Farm Partners, Crewe, which sold for £2,500. Another second calver from the same home Clayden Bestman Rose sold for £2,450.

The first prize pedigree heifer Roydonwich Escape Ruth 2 from Andrew Mallinson, Essex, sold for £2,450. The second prize pedigree heifer Pordenack Burner Dayana also made £2,450 from Malcolm Trevor-Jones, Oswestry.

Andrew Mallinson received the top two prices for pedigree heifers - £2,500 for Roydonwich Agronaut Filbert and £2,480 for Roydonwich Chamber Clinker with another at £2,450. Andrew's best six heifers averaged £2,317.

Other pedigree heifers over £2,000 included £2,100 from Robert Horton, Northwich, and £2,020 and £2,000 from Andrew Mallinson.

Ray Brown & Partners, Holmes Chapel averaged £2,177 for their three pedigree cows with second calvers at £2,300 and £2,280.

The non-pedigree section was topped at £2,400 by the first prize heifer from John and Ebs Whittaker, Tabley at £2,400.

The second prize non-pedigree heifer was an Ayrshire from Malcolm Trevor-Jones selling for £2,280. Malcolm also had the best price for a non-pedigree cow of £2,250 for a second calver.

The trade for all cattle was exceptional with everything sold. Sixth calvers sold to £1,680, seventh calvers to £1,350, 2 bullers to £1,190, 5 weanlings to £550 and 23 heifer calves to £210.
